- Any others recommendation?






New Jersey Chapter Academic Program Committee



Mark Bess who is Faculty at the New Jersey Institute of Technology (NJIT) is also the Faculty Adviser for the Chapter. He keeps the liaison between CSI New Jersey Chapter and NJIT. Mark has incorporated some aspects of the CDT prep class into System 7 class which he teach to senior students of NJIT. He has also required his class to attend CSI monthly meeting which was held in City University of NJ which was intended to be an educational session for both professionals and students. Lead Architect from STV Inc., David Augustine walked through a building that was a joint venture with Michael Graves and spoke of the design considerations and specification. Academic programs such as this fosters dialogue between Faculty, Students, Owner, Architect, Manufacturers and other related Building Industry professionals.






New Jersey Chapter Academic Program Committee
